Large print copies of service booklets and hymn books are available. Please ask one of the people welcoming you as you come in.



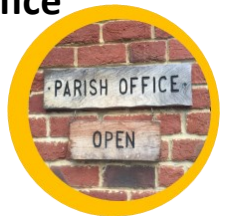
Gluten free wafers are available, please ask.

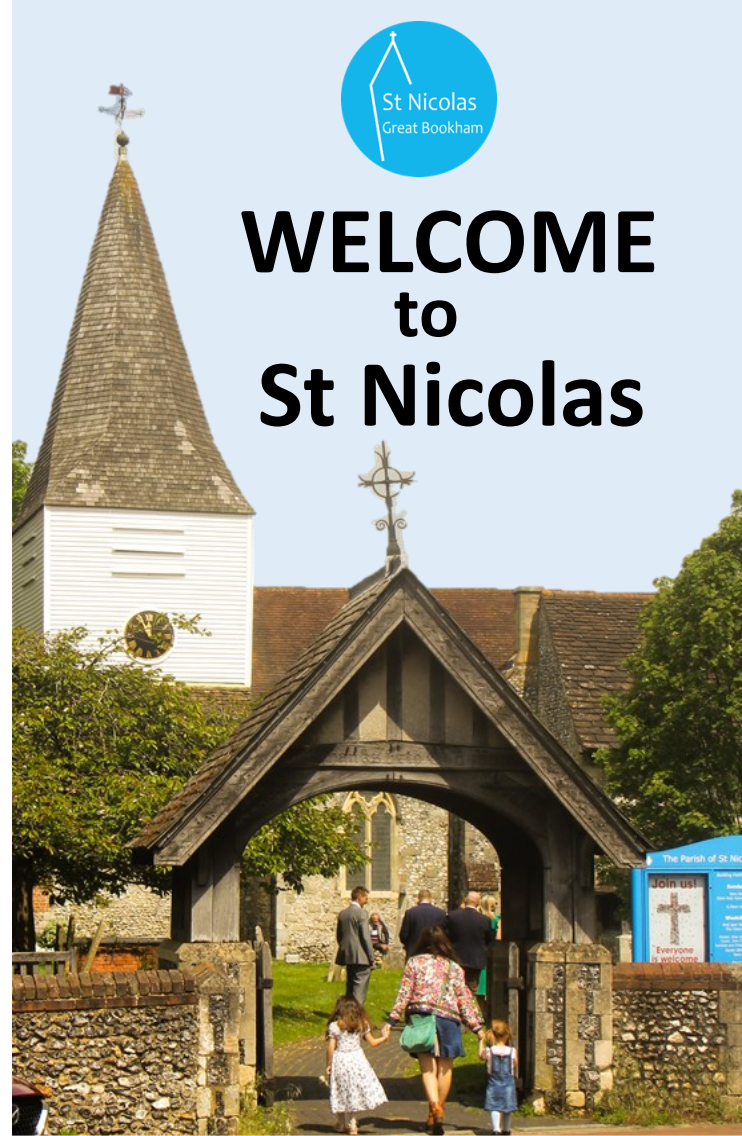
